EOF Celebrates 25 Years

The New Jersey Educational Opportunity Fund Professional Association (NJEOFFPA) will mark the Silver Anniversary of EOF at the Association's Annual Conference, April 10 through 12, 1994. In addition to professional workshops and the Senior Achievement Awards luncheon, the conference will feature a celebration of "The EOF Legacy in Higher Education," a twenty-five year tradition of providing economically and educationally disadvantaged state residents with meaningful access to New Jersey colleges and universities. Former Governor Thomas Kean is expected to attend to receive an award recognizing his early contribution to higher education: Kean was a major co-sponsor of the legislation that established EOF in 1968. Since that time, EOF has made it possible for tens of thousands to attend and to graduate from junior and senior colleges throughout the state.

Among those EOF students who will graduate with distinction are three students in the Cook College Class of 1994. Jose A. Arroyo, Krupa Patel and Scott C.
