The deadline for submitting your online SEBS Scholarship Application is Friday, April 10, 2026.

You are required to read this section carefully before beginning the online SEBS Scholarship Application. The SEBS Application utilizes Qualtrics software. Therefore, the following recommendations are required to be followed for a successful submission of your scholarship application:

- **Please answer all questions. Please note: you must complete all required questions on each page to be able to proceed to the next page of the application.**
- **It is strongly recommended that your online application be submitted at one time with your application documents fully completed before. Review carefully the sample copy of the application listed below to help you prepare and complete your documents listed in the “Essay and Supplemental Documents” section BEFORE starting your on-line application.**
- **If you do not complete your application and return back to your online application at another time, you may not be able to return to where you previously left off and you may have to start your application over again. A cell phone cannot be used. It is strongly recommended to complete your application at one time to avoid processing delays.**

- **Once your application is submitted, it is considered final, and you will not be able to go back and make further changes.**

Please plan ahead to complete your scholarship application no later than April 10, 2026. SEBS Scholarship Application includes six parts: 1) Personal Information 2) Financial Aid Information (if applicable) 3) 2026-2027 Enrollment Status 4) Additional Scholarship Questions 5) Reich Scholarship Questions 6) Essay and Supplemental Documents.

The final section: “Essay and Supplemental Documents” includes these document uploads at the end of the application:

- PDF Format only: Attach a mandatory (at least a one-page) typed statement describing your college career, future goals, and special circumstances you would like to be considered. (If necessary, please note that up to two paragraphs maximum can be dedicated to your financial need situation, however your statement should not be entirely devoted to this area.)

- PDF Format only: If available, you are encouraged to attach a copy of your resume to support your application.


